TOP TIP

The Carnic High Route in the Carnic Alps Geo Park

The long-distance trail leads in freely selectable stages along the main ridge of the Carnic Alps, past numerous mountain lakes. Some sections are designed as geological nature trails, so-called geotrails. Interesting facts about 500 million years of the earth's history are conveyed and mysterious graptolites, plant fossils, beautifully shaped shells, fossilised prehistoric triops and cephalopods can be discovered here.

The Carnic Milky Way enhances the unique hiking experience in the Hike World.

Exciting constellations on various themes line the Carnic High Route and invite to discover the trail in a completely new dimension.

"Pure nature" is the best way to describe the unique symbiosis of water, meadow and forest – whether on the mountain or at the lake. Walking and hiking trails lead around the lake or almost everywhere directly from the lakeshore (930 m above sea level) to the extensive Hike World of the Nature Park at Lake Weissensee.

TOP TIP

Weissensee Slow Trail

This unique hiking trail leads directly along the lake, with short elevated sections, from the west shore to the east shore. Stunning views with the lake's display of colours ranging from dark green to turquoise blue! Idyllic bays and places for a rest create a feeling of relaxation and "pure nature". Stop for refreshment on the eastern shore with a view of the Lienz Dolomites.

The way back is pleasant: e.g. on board the "MS Alpenperle" with environmentally friendly hybrid drive.

"Hiking support" is provided by the Weissensee boat services or the summer mountain railway. Places for rest and refreshment are located directly at the lake or on the alpine pastures, where you can enjoy Weissensee fish as well as regional delicacies.

Since every accommodation at Lake Weissensee has its own lakeside beach, a dive into the lake, with water temperatures of up to 25 degrees, is also a "must" after a hiking tour.

- Weissensee Slow Trail on the lakeshore return by boat
- Leisure tour with habitat observation and raft trip with fish sampling
